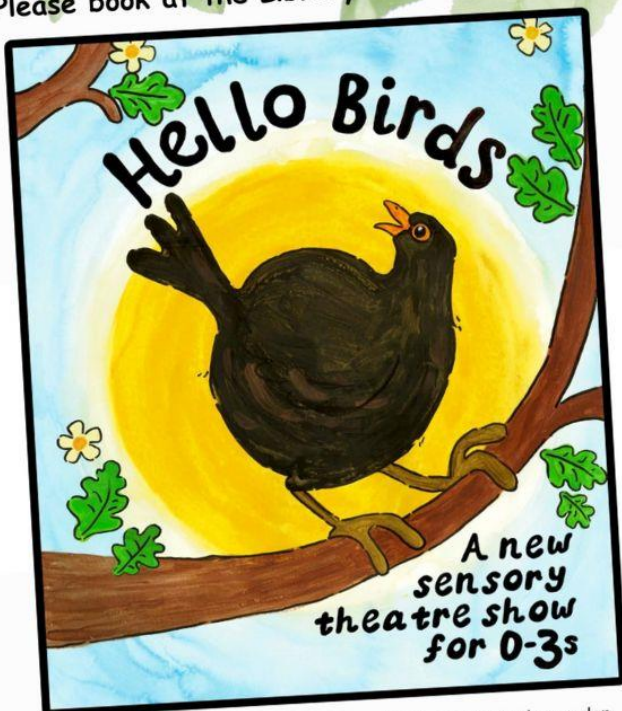

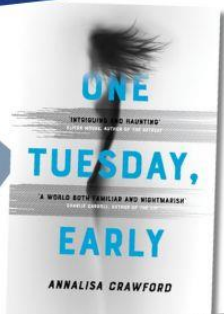
Cornish butterflies, bugs and more.

Thursday 13th June 11am

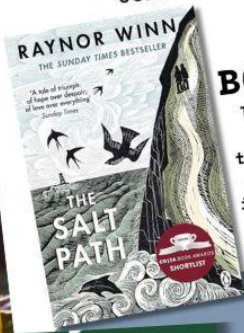
Join Bran the Gardener as we greet the birds that visit the garden.
